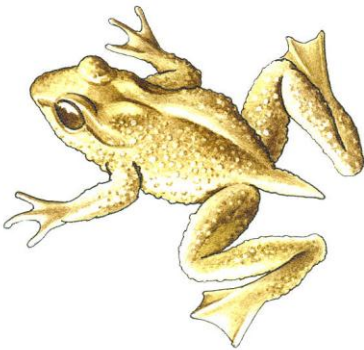
The entrance is unmarked, but Andaloro WMA can be located using maps app. Meet in parking lot.
